Manuscript Consultations

Conference participants will have the opportunity to meet with Drs. Loue and Geltman during the morning of Saturday, June 17. The consultations will take place between 9:30 – 11:45 AM. Participants wishing to meet with the editors must submit a manuscript, abstract, or outline in advance of the conference.

Materials should be sent to sx154@case.edu and pgeltman@franciscanchildrens.org. In a cover letter, participants must specify their goals for the consultation and relevance to *JIMH*. The editors will assign times to selected participants. The length of time will be determined by the number of requests but is anticipated to be 15 minutes. The schedule will be posted at the registration desk on the first day of the conference.

The purpose of the activity is to provide conference participants a mentoring opportunity on manuscript preparation and publication. Editors will assess materials on their likely interest to readership and generalizability, offer a critique of content and manuscript structure, and provide guidance on the submission and/or revision process (including guidance on critiques of manuscripts previously submitted to *JIMH*).
